MICROAGGRESSIONS IN CLINICAL EDUCATION

Students from graduate AT programs report experiencing microaggressions, including microinvalidation, microinsults, and microassaults in clinical and didactic education from various stakeholders, including preceptors, coaches, and peer students. Following these incidents of microaggressions, students did not act because they perceived there were no formal reporting mechanisms. In turn, students would feel anxious and feel the need to self-cope. Finally, experiencing microaggressions and lacking reporting mechanisms caused students to reconsider whether AT is the right profession for them or decide to eliminate certain settings from career opportunities.
