CAATE e-accreditation modules are now live!!!

These modules are now live and available to Programs.

Student Cohort: The student cohort module allows Program Directors (or their designee) to enter student information for each cohort. The student cohort module contains student:

- demographics
- retention and attrition
- BOC candidate ID and results (integrated in July)
- on-time graduation tracking
- post-graduation employment

Internal Program Review: This module encourages the Program to complete a very brief (e.g., two sentences and a qualitative pick-list selection) internal review of each Standard every year between Self-Studies.

- Allows programs to monitor progress on standards for programs NOT completing a self study within two years
- Is not viewable by CAATE
- Information entered into IPR is NOT transferred to Self Study

File Cabinet: This utility provides each Program with private, online storage file folders that can be accessed at any time.

- Programs may file copies of documents in this location that may be useful during their re-accreditation process.
- Programs file documents here when using the IPR
- Provides Programs with some degree of confidence that accreditation-related documents won't be lost due to staff / Program Director turnover.

Curriculum Module: This module allows the program to list all core courses in the curriculum and map to the knowledge, skills, and abilities taught in the program to specific courses.

- Programs may enter instruction and assessment methods for KSAs (competencies)
- Provides a central place to store syllabi for core courses.

Annual Report: **Annual reports will be due October 15th, 2013.**

- Programs will report annual information about the program including:
 - Faculty profiles
 - Clinical site profiles
 - Preceptor profiles
 - Student cohorts
 - Institution Profile
 - Specific Annual Report Questions
