### ADMINISTRATOR MEMBER VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

The Commission on Accreditation of Athletic Training Education (CAATE) is pleased to announce selection for the following vacancy:

- **One** (1) seat on the CAATE Commission for an Administrative Member. Term begins at the Summer/Fall meeting of 2017. The elected person will begin attending meetings in a non-voting capacity starting with the Spring 2017 meeting February 24-25, 2017.

#### ***About the CAATE***

The Commission is a voluntary non-governmental specialized accreditor for Professional and Post-Professional Degree and Residency Programs in Athletic Training. The Commission consists of six (6) BOC certified athletic trainers elected by the accredited programs, four (4) sponsoring organization representatives, a physician 'at-large' member, one (1) public member, and one (1) institution administrator. The terms of each Commissioner is 3 years. Commissioners may serve no more than two (2) consecutive terms.

***Commission Functions:*** Oversee voluntary non-governmental specialized accreditation, adopt Standards that govern acceptable practices, make final accreditation decisions, develop and maintain a collaborative and publically accessible process for policies and procedures, maintain accreditation records, encourage innovation in athletic training educational programs beyond the requirements delineated in the Standards, maintain and make publicly available the accreditation status of all accredited programs.

**Selection Process:** Selected by the Commission.

**Term of Office:** Three (3) years with no more than two (2) consecutive terms. (6-year maximum)

**Required Qualifications:**

1) *Qualifications for the Administrator member:*

a) An administrator of an institution with a CAATE accredited athletic training program.

b) Knowledge of health professions

c) Knowledge of regional and programmatic accreditation

d) Likely candidates are solicited from recommendations by the CAATE-accredited programs, higher education community, other accreditors and the public at large.

**Desirable Qualifications:**

1) Administrator of a unit containing other health professions as well as AT

**Application:**

1. Current vita/resume;

2. Letter of interest for the Commission; addressing their interest in athletic training accreditation.

**Application Process:**
